OYSC Shootout Procedure

If the game is tied at the end of regulation (or the overtime of a bracket final), a winner will be determined through a shootout. Shootouts will done as follows:

- Each coach will select 5 kickers from their entire roster. Those kickers will alternate. When the first 10 have kicked, if one team is ahead, the game is over
- If the shootout is tied, each coach will select 5 kickers **not** used already. Those 5 will alternate kicks with a victory after any pair.
- If, after 10 kickers from each time, the score is still tied, each coach will select 5 more kickers from the entire roster. Those 5 will alternate kicks with a victory after any pair.
- If the game is still tied, each coach will select 5 additional kickers **not** used in the previous set to alternate kicks, with a victory after any pair. Continue alternating until a victory is achieved.

In U19 - Coed, shootouts for each team will start with a girl, then alternate boy, girl and so on.
